# OBJECTIVES OF THE WHOLE CONFERENCE

- 1. Discredit the conventional assumptions, beliefs and practice that impede a politically viable discourse over the contribution of culture to social and economic regeneration.
- 2. Inspire the cultural operators to reconsider their views regarding their role and the role of culture in the contemporary society in Europe. Broaden up your views, act responsible!
  - 3. Enable exchange, significant by a political perspective, between different players, by testing specific methodologies and formats in the context of a conference
- 4. With regard to issues fundamental in the current and future time, extract suggestions for possible relevant policies.
- 5. Foster the agglutination of a community engaged in advocating and practicing CAE aims.
